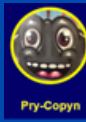
DOSBARTH DRAENOG

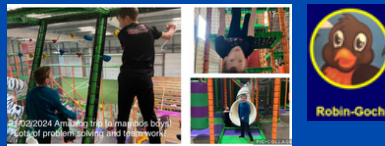


DOSBARTH PRY-COPYN

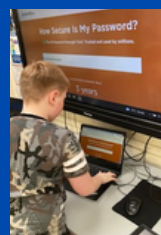
