DOSBARTH GWDIHW

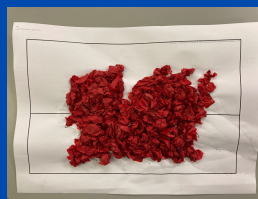

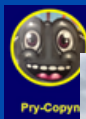
Red Nose Day

Cath Cairns visited the school last week and held workshops with all the pupils. They absolutely loved the sessions and produced some amazing pieces of art. Diolch Cath.

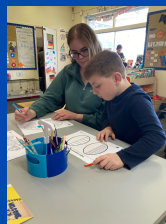
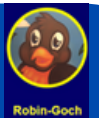


DOSBARTH PRY-COPYN

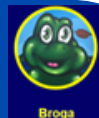
DOSBARTH ROBIN GOCH
