Ambitious, Capable Learners week.

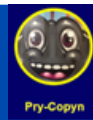

DOSBARTH PRY-COPYN

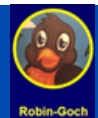


Super listening and interacting with PC Rhys' Internet Safety workshop
